Safety and Supervision		
	Teacher is present in the classroom, especially during times when children are actively moving around or potential for danger is higher	
	When in the classroom, teacher is actively watching children and moving around the classroom to ensure groups are properly supervised	
	Measures are taken to ensure the physical safety of children	
Interactions with Children		
	Quality of teacher/student interactions is generally warm, positive, playful, supportive, etc.	
	Teacher listens to children more than sh/he talks	
	Teacher engages children in conversation designed to further thinking. Questions are open-ended	
	Group times are engaging and age-appropriate. Children are allowed opportunities but not forced to contribute.	
Interactions with Adults		
	Communicates with co-teacher in a pro-social way, modeling positive interactions for children and parents.	
	Social conversations and those not immediately relevant are kept to a minimum	
	Works collaboratively with co-teacher, fair distribution of classroom responsibilities	
Other Responsibilities		
	Observation notes are detailed and informative - demonstrate understanding of children's personalities, strengths, challenges	
	Lesson plans are executed in class, materials and all are prepared before the start of the day
